**U46 issues alert about recalled eggs**

Streamwood High School students were served salad containing recalled hard-cooked eggs during lunch service Thursday, Elgin School District U46 said Friday.

A nationwide precautionary recall of GFS-brand hard-cooked eggs was not issued until after lunch service had ended Thursday, U46 said. It notified parents of Streamwood students Friday that the eggs had been served at the school.

Those eggs could be contaminated Listeria monocytogenes. U46 vendor Michael Foods told the district that the voluntary recall is precautionary and there have been no reported illness. The recall is the result of lab testing that showed the eggs may contain the Listeria.

Only two salads were sold Thursday at Streamwood, and the risk of student illness is very low, according to the district's message. That message was sent to all parents at the school because U46 is unable to identify which students purchased the salads.

Listeria symptoms include high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain, and diarrhea. Students who ate a salad with hard-cooked egg Thursday and have any of those symptoms should contact a health care provider, U46 said.

Jan. 27--Spartan Stores has announced the recall of deli products sold between certain dates that may be contaminated with Listeria.

The products all have hard-cooked eggs in them, and a sell-by date of January 20 to February 1. The eggs were produced by Michael Foods of Minnetonka, Minn. The voluntary recall was made after a voluntary recall by Michael Foods.

The Spartan deli products recalled are: --Egg spread --Egg sandwich with egg spread --Small chef salad --Large chef salad --No meat small chef salad --No meat large chef salad --No meat seven layer salad Spartan Stores says they have not heard of anyone getting sick from the products. Anyone with a concern about an illness is asked to contact a healthcare provider immediately.

Additionally, the USDA has issued a recall associated with Michael Foods eggs for 18th Street Deli, Inc. products, which is a company based out of Hamtramck, Mich.

The 18th Street Deli recall affects 9.25-ounce packages of 18th Street Deli Julienne Salad and Salad Lite with the number P-22061 inside the USA mark, and expiration dates of 01/27/12 and 01/30/12.
